An Ordinance Prohibiting Video Gaming

WHEREAS, the Village of Norridge (Village), as a home rule municipality in accordance with Article VII Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, is enacting this Ordinance to provide for the protection of the public health and welfare by prohibiting the use of video gaming devices within the Village of Norridge; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Village to prohibit the use of video gaming devices within the Village.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1.

That facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2.

That the following is enacted as Chapter 10, Section 10-9 of the Revised Municipal Code of the Village of Norridge – 2002:

**Sec. 10-9 – Video Gaming Prohibited**

- A. Pursuant to the authority vested in the village by section 27 of the Illinois Video Gaming Act (230 ILCS 40/1 et seq.), video gaming is hereby prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village of Norridge.
- B. It shall be the duty of the village clerk and the ordinance enforcement officers to administer and enforce the terms and provisions of this section and to make or cause to be made such inspection of the buildings or premises as may be necessary to accomplish such administration or enforcement.
- C. Refusal of any business license holder to allow inspection of the entire premises shall be grounds for the revocation of the business license until such time as inspection is allowed.

Section 3.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
